Phil Roberts e-Learning Scholarship

This scholarship is designed to allow iMIS users to advance their organization through training, education, and professional development BUT without any travel expense and on their own schedule. Two (2) recipients will be awarded this scholarship valued at \$250.

Each award includes access to a package of recorded conference sessions and related materials – aka a virtual conference - tailored to the recipient’s educational needs. Options include an Administrator Package, Basic User Package, Web Module (RiSE) Package, or a Reporting Package. Each package includes one (1) full day of training OR two (2) half-days of training and 6 related breakout sessions.

Qualifications

Applicants must be a NiUG member in good standing for at least one (1) year and submit a completed scholarship application with required documentation.

Requirements

1. All applicants must complete the scholarship application and submit supporting documentation.
2. All applications must be received by August 30, 2019.
3. If awarded, applicants agree their names being used in promotional materials including but not limited to the NiUG Listserve, NiUG website, and NiUG social media outlets.

The winners of the scholarship will be notified by October 1, 2019 and will have access granted to their package of conference sessions via our Live Learning Center for one full year (November 1, 2019 – October 31, 2020).
